Objective

Vanguard Emerging Markets ETF seeks to track the performance of a benchmark index that measures the investment return of stocks issued by companies located in emerging market countries.

Investment Strategy

Vanguard Emerging Markets ETF employs a "passive management"—or indexing—investment approach by investing substantially all (normally about 95%) assets in the common stocks included in the Select Emerging Markets Index. The Select Emerging Markets Index includes common stocks of companies located in emerging markets around the world. The largest markets covered in the Index are South Korea, South Africa, Taiwan, Brazil, and China. Other countries represented in the Index include Argentina, Chile, the Czech Republic, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Israel, Mexico, Peru, the Philippines, Poland, Thailand, and Turkey. MSCI administers the Select Emerging Markets Index exclusively for Vanguard.
